Its primary role is to ensure patient safety, minimize risks, improve drug development, and support regulatory decisions to promote public health.

➤ **Functions of Pharmacovigilance Committee**

- I. Detection of Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs):** Identifies unexpected and harmful side effects of medications.
- II.Safety Monitoring (Signal Detection):** Continuously monitors the safety profile of drugs, including using methods like disproportionality analysis to detect new signals in safety databases.
- III.Risk Management:** Develops strategies to minimize risks associated with medications, including updating drug labels and managing product recalls.
- IV.Regulatory Compliance:** Submits safety data, such as Periodic Safety Update Reports (PSURs) and PADERs, to regulatory authorities.
- V.Benefit-Risk Assessment:** Evaluates the overall benefit-risk balance of medicinal products to ensure they are safe for public use.
- VI.Patient Education and Information:** Communicates risk information to healthcare professionals and the public.
